Watersports and flotilla holidays

Whether you want all out action on the water or prefer quiet relaxation - take a sailing type holiday.

These holidays are suitable for both sailors and non-sailors, singles, couples and families.

This type of holiday can offer everything from dinghy racing to windsurfing, from flotilla sailing to kayaking and childcare to spa treatments.

Club type holidays

The typical day consists:

Learn to sail or windsurf clinics, yacht handling, exploring the locality by mountain-bike, enjoying a game of tennis or simply soak up the sun by chilling out round the pool.

Children are looked after well too. There are free all day kids clubs offering daily sailing lessons, tennis, volleyball, painting, treasure-hunts – all with qualified Nannies and Child-care assistants.

SAFETY is the priority. All instructors are RYA approved.

Sailing Dinghies used: Laser 2000s and Hobie Pacifics.

Windsurfers used: Starboard Kombats, Flares, Evos, Acids, and tandem Gemenis.

3 day Flotilla Training course

To teach you the basics of sailing a cruising yacht, including sail handling, mooring, basic ropework, and theory. This leads to you being able to Skipper a yacht on an 'easy' graded flotilla holiday.

Yachts used are for example Dufour 30s

What is a flotilla?

A group of yachts which sail with a 'lead crew'. Basically you all sail on line of sight legs from place to place at a leisurely pace. Stopping off at harbours, villages, secluded bays. You can even just drop anchor and catch up with the rest later!

The lead yacht will have a qualified skipper who will brief you in the morning as to the planned route, moorings etc. The lead yacht also has the hostess who organises the restaurants, BBQs etc.

There is an engineer available in radio contact for breakdowns, repairs, maintenance etc.

Flotillas are graded from Easy to Difficult (level 0 to 3)
